

4th Edition of the King Salman International Prize for Disability Research

The Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Regional Integration and International Trade has announced that the King Salman Centre for Disability Research is launching its 4th edition of the King Salman International Prize for Disability Research.

2. The deadline for submission of the Disability Research is March 2026 and that the winner will be announced in December 2026.

3. This award targets scientific and research institutions and distinguished researchers who have produced scientific output in accordance with the announced term and conditions. The awards will be granted on the basis of appreciation to institutions, scientific bodies and individuals who have presented quality research works with tangible impacts on improving the quality-of-life persons with disabilities, to deepen international research cooperation and to support systematic innovation to reduce disability and address its various repercussions.

4. The Prizes include a financial grant of (500,000) Saudi Riyals (SAR), equivalent to (133, 333) US Dollars (USD), a Certificate of appreciation, and a medal commemorating the winning work all of which are presented for each category. The categories are as follows:

- Health and Medical Science
- Educational and Psychological
- Rehabilitation and Social Sciences
- Technical Application in Areas of Disability
- Universal Access.
